(IMPOSITION OF 50 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 201

The Leicestershire County Council (“the Council”) in exercise of its powers under Sections 5 and 84 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”) and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The Leicestershire County Council (A426 Lutterworth, Bitteswell and Ashby Parva) (In the District of Harborough and District of Blaby) (Imposition of 50 mph Speed Limit) Order 201
2. The order shall come into force on the day of 201
3. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on the roads specified in the Schedule to this order.
4. The plan annexed to this Order and marked ‘Drawing No. P640/T1/1’ is for identification purposes only.

SCHEDULE

A426, Lutterworth Road

From a point 165 metres south of its junction with Dog and Gun Lane, Whetstone to a point 257m North of its junction with the B581 Coopers Lane and Station Road, Dunton Bassett.

A426, Lutterworth Road & Leicester Road

From a point 215m South of its junction with Dunton Road, Ashby Magna to a point 173 metres north of its junction with Bill Crane Way, Lutterworth.
